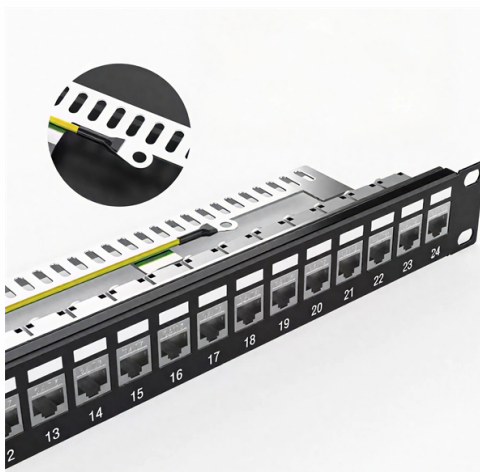


Are all the wires in the distribution box live
