- Core: The central strand of highly pure glass, usually 9–50 microns in diameter, where light signals travel .
- Cladding: A surrounding layer of glass with lower purity that keeps the light confined within the core through total internal reflection .
- Coating: A thin acrylate layer that protects the fiber from handling damage while spooling . Unlike pre-terminated fiber cables, bare fiber is lightweight and flexible, allowing network designers to add only the necessary protective layers for specific applications .

Types

- Single-mode bare fiber: Optimized for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications such as telecom backbones .



- Multi-mode bare fiber: Suitable for short-range applications like data centers and local area networks (LANs), .
- Specialty fibers: Includes polarization-maintaining, photosensitive, and double-clad fibers for advanced optical systems .
