A ground wire, also known as a grounding wire or ground conductor (GEC and EGC), as the name implies, is an electrical wire connected from the transformer and main panel (or distribution board) to the ground rod or earthing plate via ground electrode conductor (GEC), also known as an earthing lead. Connect the ground rods with a No. 4/0 AWG bare, stranded copper ground wire loop. Pigtails from the ground wire loop shall be used to ground the manhole cover frame, ladder, concrete inserts or cable
