They provide good ventilation and are ideal for low-voltage or fiber optic cables.

5. **Channel Cable Tray** Channel trays are U-shaped or C-shaped and designed for light-duty applications or single-cable support. They are often used in commercial or institutional settings for backbone or horizontal distribution. While they provide less ventilation than ladder or perforated trays, they are compact and cost-effective for smaller cable runs.

Material Considerations

Cable trays can be metallic (aluminum, steel, stainless steel) or non-metallic (fiberglass-reinforced plastic, FRP).
