Fiber optic internet transmits data as light signals, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The ONT, typically provided and installed by your ISP, serves as the conversion device, translating the optical signals from the fiber into electrical signals via Ethernet that your router can understand and distribute to devices . Without this conversion, the router cannot process the fiber signal.

How the Connection Works

- Fiber Cable to ONT: The fiber optic cable from your ISP connects to the ONT's optical port. This port receives the light signal and converts it into an electrical signal using a photodiode .



- **ONT to Router:** An Ethernet cable links the ONT's Ethernet output to your router's WAN port. This allows the router to manage your home network and provide internet access to multiple devices .

- **Router Configuration:** Once connected, the router may require configuration for VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings depending on your ISP .

Router Requirements

Not all routers are compatible with fiber internet. Your router must have a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle high-speed fiber connections. Older routers designed for DSL or cable may not support the speeds offered by fiber, so a modern router with Wi-Fi 6 or higher is recommended to fully utilize the connection .

Direct Connection to ONT

Technically, you can connect a single device directly to the ONT without a router, but this is uncommon. Direct connection limits the number of devices and bypasses network management features like Wi-Fi, firewall, and multiple device support . For most home setups, using a router after the ONT is the standard approach.
