Before checking optical power, ensure the SFP module is recognized by the switch:

- Run show inventory to confirm the SFP is detected, including part number, serial number, and vendor information .
- Check link status with show interfaces status to ensure the port is up and the correct media type is used .

Step 2: Check Optical Power

For Cisco switches, the commands vary by platform: Catalyst / Enterprise Switches:

- Use show interfaces transceiver detail or show interface transceiver detail to display TX and RX power in dBm, along with temperature, voltage, and bias current .
- Example output includes:
 - TX Power: Light leaving the switch (indicates laser health)
 - RX Power: Light received from the remote device (common cause of link issues if low)

Small Business Switches:

- Use `show fiber-ports optical-transceiver` to view optical module status, including transmitted and received power, temperature, voltage, and loss-of-signal (LOS) indicators . Other Platforms (IOS-XR, NX-OS):
 - Commands like `show hw-module subslot transceiver status` or filtering with `| include dB` can display TX/RX power for troubleshooting .
- Step 3: Interpret the Values
- Compare TX and RX readings against the SFP's Low Warn and High Warn thresholds. Deviations may indicate:
 - Misaligned fiber
 - Dirty connectors
 - Failing SFP module
 - Typical TX/RX ranges depend on the SFP type (e.g., 1G, 10G) and fiber distance .
- Step 4: Additional Checks
- If the port is err-disabled due to unsupported transceivers, use `no errdisable detect cause gbic-invalid` (with caution) to allow third-party modules .
 - For detailed SFP info, including EEPROM data, run `show idprom interface` or `show idprom transceiver extended` . By following these steps, you can monitor optical power, detect signal degradation early, and troubleshoot fiber link issues without unnecessary hardware replacement.
