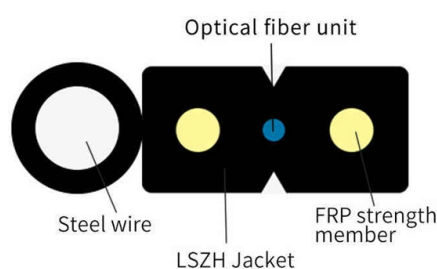

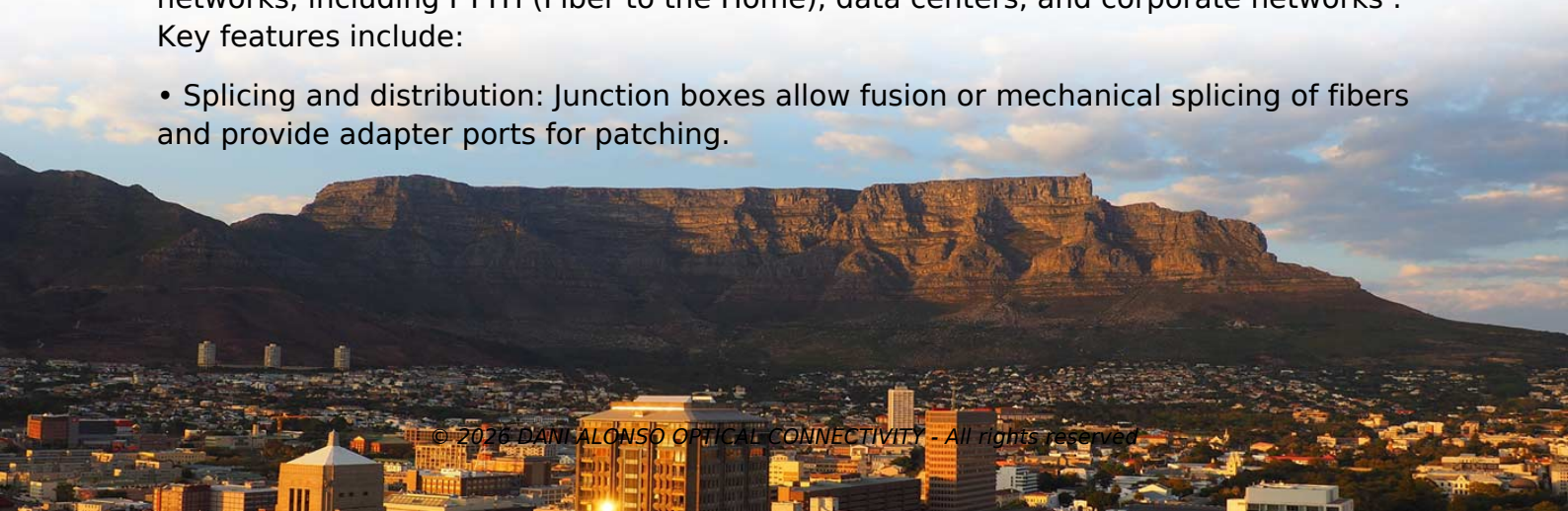

Fiber Optic Junction Boxes

Fiber optic junction boxes (also called splice boxes or terminal boxes) are enclosures that protect and organize fiber connections. They are used in indoor and outdoor networks, including FTTH (Fiber to the Home), data centers, and corporate networks. Key features include:

- Splicing and distribution: Junction boxes allow fusion or mechanical splicing of fibers and provide adapter ports for patching.



- Capacity and modularity: Boxes can accommodate multiple splicing trays, adapters, or distribution plates, supporting up to 48 channels or 96 fibers in some models .
- Protection and organization: They maintain the minimum bend radius of fibers, separate spliced and unconnected fibers, and often include dust covers or lockable lids .
- Mounting options: Available as wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or DIN rail boxes, with versions for 1-gang or 2-gang installations and angled or flat adapters for aesthetic integration .

Couplers are typically installed inside junction boxes to facilitate fiber termination and patching. For example, a wall-mounted fiber optic box may include LC couplers for single-mode or multimode fibers, allowing easy connection to network equipment . Junction boxes also support keystone modules, which are color-coded for quick identification and compatibility with different fiber types and transmission speeds .
