Overview

An electrical distribution box is an enclosed panel that receives incoming power and splits it into multiple downstream circuits. Isolation switches, also known as disconnecter switches or isolators, are mechanical switching devices designed to ensure that an electrical circuit can be completely de-energized for safe maintenance, inspection, or repair work. Unlike circuit breakers that protect against overloads and short. Simply put, isolation blocks unwanted DC and AC currents between separate parts of a system while transferring desired signals and/or power. It is a critical safety component in solar systems, industrial machines, and outdoor panels — allowing manual. This procedure has been established to provide a minimum standard for the isolation and lockout of power distribution equipment in accordance with the guidelines and standards set out in the Alberta OH&S Code, CSA C22. Each outgoing line can be individually.
