- Restart (Reboot): Recommended for minor connectivity issues, slow internet speeds, or after adding new devices or changing network settings. Restarting clears temporary glitches, refreshes the router's memory, and can renew your IP address without affecting saved settings .
- Factory Reset: Only necessary if problems persist after a restart, such as repeated connection drops, forgotten passwords, or configuration errors. A factory reset restores the router to default settings, erasing all custom configurations, including Wi-Fi names and passwords .

How to Restart Your Fiber Router

- Power off the router: Unplug the power cord or use the power switch.
- Wait briefly: Allow at least 10-30 seconds for the device to fully power down .

- Power on the router: Plug it back in and wait for the indicator lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes .

How to Factory Reset Your Fiber Router

- Locate the reset button: Usually a small recessed button on the back or base of the router .
- Press and hold the button: Use a paperclip or pin for 10–15 seconds until the lights indicate a reset.
- Reconfigure settings: After reboot, you may need to set up Wi-Fi names, passwords, and other network configurations .

Precautions

- Save any ongoing work to prevent data loss.
- Notify other users on the network before restarting or resetting.
- Keep your ISP login credentials handy in case reconfiguration is needed .

Maintenance Tip

Even without issues, it's good practice to restart your router periodically, such as once a month, to maintain optimal performance and clear accumulated memory . In summary, restart your fiber router for routine issues or performance improvements, and reserve a factory reset for persistent or severe problems that cannot be resolved by a simple reboot.
