Standard home routers typically do not accept a direct fiber optic cable because the fiber signal must be converted from light to electrical signals. This conversion is performed by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which is provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP) and installed near where the fiber enters your home . The ONT has a fiber input port and outputs data via a standard Ethernet port, which then connects to your router's WAN port .

Router Ports and Labels

If a router is fiber-ready, it may include an SFP port or a port labeled "Fiber," "FTTH," or "PON" that can accept a fiber module . These ports are sometimes located on the back or bottom of the router, often behind a small panel. However, most consumer routers only have Ethernet WAN ports, meaning the fiber cable cannot be plugged in directly .

How to Connect Fiber Internet

- Fiber cable from ISP → ONT fiber port
- ONT Ethernet output → Router WAN port
- Router LAN ports → Devices like computers, smart TVs, or switches This setup ensures proper signal conversion and network functionality .
