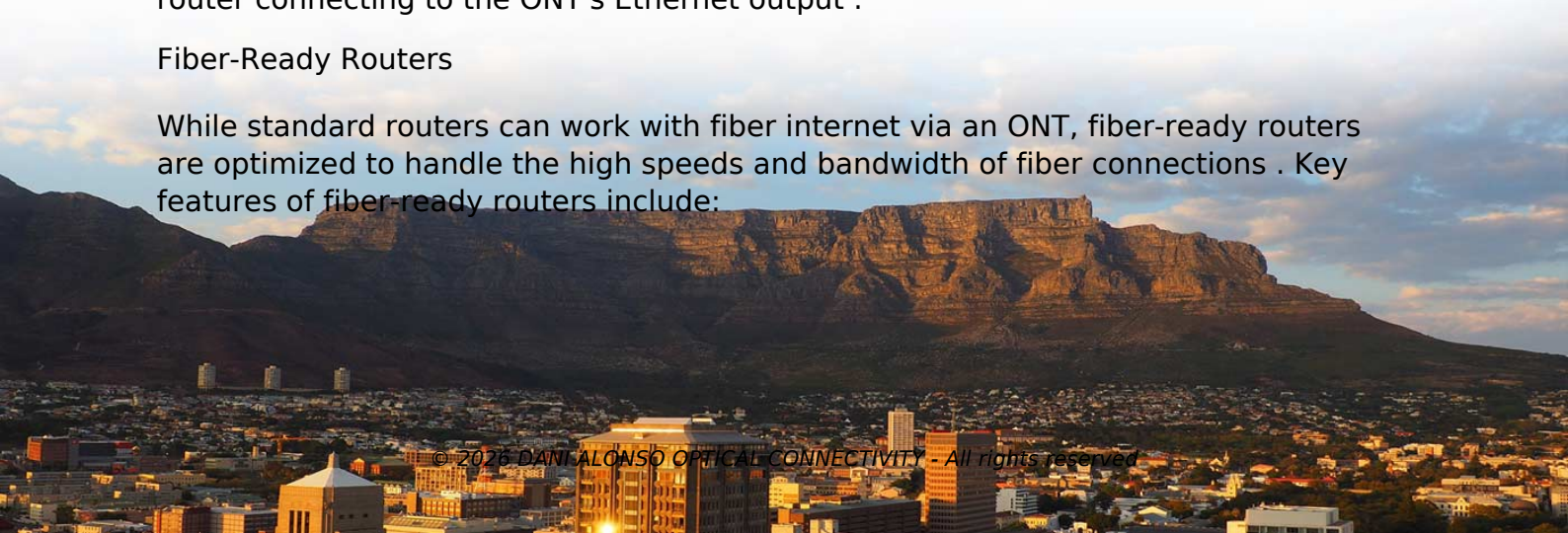

Fiber optic cables carry data as pulses of light, which cannot be directly interpreted by standard routers that use Ethernet ports for electrical signals. To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your ISP. The ONT converts the light-based fiber signal into a standard Ethernet signal, which your router can then use to distribute internet throughout your home or office. Most residential setups use this two-device arrangement, with the fiber cable connecting to the ONT and the router connecting to the ONT's Ethernet output.

Fiber-Ready Routers

While standard routers can work with fiber internet via an ONT, fiber-ready routers are optimized to handle the high speeds and bandwidth of fiber connections. Key features of fiber-ready routers include:



- Gigabit or multi-gigabit Ethernet ports to match fiber speeds.
- Advanced wireless standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for faster wireless performance.
- WAN port compatibility for connecting to the ONT.
- Some high-end models include SFP/SFP+ ports, allowing direct connection to fiber transceivers, though this is less common in typical home setups .

Popular routers suitable for fiber internet include:

- NETGEAR Nighthawk RS700S WiFi 7 Router: Supports multi-gig speeds, Wi-Fi 7, and LAN aggregation for up to 2 Gbps wired speeds .
- ASUS RT-AC86U AC2900: Offers stable Wi-Fi performance, low latency, and robust security features for gaming and streaming .
- Ufiber UF-WiFi6: A budget-friendly option for GPON fiber environments, providing reliable Wi-Fi 6 performance for everyday use .

For optimal performance, especially with high-speed fiber plans, using a fiber-ready router with gigabit or multi-gigabit support and modern Wi-Fi standards is recommended .
