Step-by-Step Repair Process

- **Identify the Damage** Inspect the cable for visible cuts, frays, or tears in the outer coating. Using an OTDR (Optical Time Domain Reflectometer) can help locate breaks precisely .
- **Cut Out the Damaged Section** Trim the cable just below the damaged area using a fiber optic cutter to ensure clean ends .
- **Strip the Cable** Remove the outer jacket and protective layers with a fiber optic stripper to expose the glass fibers. Be careful not to nick or break the fibers .
- **Clean the Fiber Ends** Use alcohol wipes or specialized cleaning tools to remove dust and debris from the exposed fibers. Clean ends are critical for low-loss connections .

- Splice or Connect the Fibers
- Mechanical Splice: Insert the fibers into a mechanical connector and secure with a crimper.
- Fusion Splice: Align the fibers in a fusion splicer and fuse them together for minimal signal loss (
