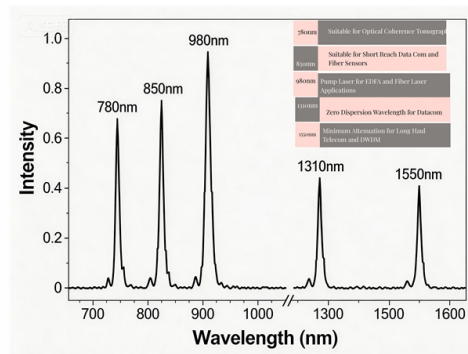


Fiber Optic Terminal Box Rail Installation Method

1. Select the Mounting Location Choose a suitable area for the terminal box on a standard 35x7mm DIN rail, ensuring accessibility for maintenance and splicing operations. The location should allow proper cable entry and avoid excessive bending of fibers . 2. Secure the Terminal Box Attach the terminal box to the DIN rail using the provided mounting hardware. Ensure the box is firmly anchored to prevent movement or vibration that could damage fibers . 3. Prepare Cable Entry Use the PG13.5 cable gland or equivalent to secure incoming fiber optic cables. Before insertion, prepare the cable ends according to the supplier's instructions, protecting the bare fibers from damage . For outdoor or industrial environments, ensure the gland provides proper sealing against dust and moisture . 4. Route Fibers Inside the Box Open the terminal box to access the splicing area. Route fibers through the internal plastic guide posts or trays to maintain the standard bend radius and prevent stress on the fibers . Excess fiber should be coiled neatly in the splice tray. 5. Splice Fibers Splice the incoming fibers to the pigtails or adapters according to the required configuration (e.g., 12 fibers for SC connectors, 24 fibers for LC connectors). Ensure proper alignment and protection of the spliced fibers using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing methods . 6. Secure and Label Connections Clamp fibers at the splice tray entry points using plastic straps or clips. Label each fiber or port clearly for future maintenance and network management . 7. Test and Inspect After installation, gently pull on fibers to confirm they are secure. Use a fiber power meter or OTDR to verify signal quality and check for weak or missing signals . Inspect the box regularly for damage, dust, or loose connections to maintain optimal performance .

- Keep the box clean and free from dust or moisture.
- Avoid sharp bends or tight loops in fiber routing.
- Periodically check cable glands and mounting hardware for stability.
