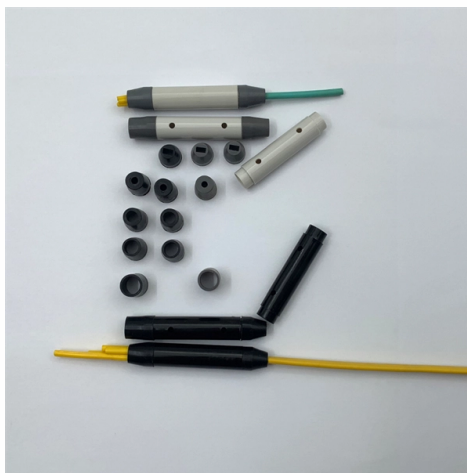

- Brackets and clamps are tested for tensile strength, temperature cycling, and corrosion resistance to ensure long-term reliability .

Best Practices

- Avoid sharp bends or excessive tension on the fiber to prevent signal loss or damage.
- Use the correct bracket size for the cable diameter to ensure a secure fit.
- Maintain proper spacing and clearance, especially near power lines or other infrastructure.
- For multiple cables, use brackets with multiple clips or guides to organize and separate fibers efficiently . By selecting the appropriate bracket type, material, and installation method, fiber optic cables can be securely fixed, protected from environmental stress, and organized for efficient network performance.
