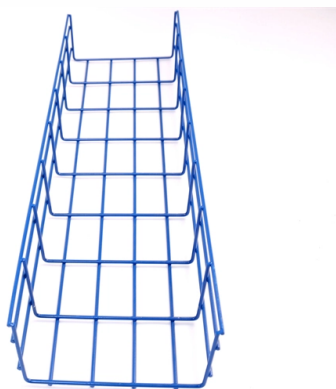

Rack-mounted fiber optic racks are usually aluminum or steel, lightweight, and designed for 19-inch standard equipment. Common models include:

- Flexi Rack 19"/ETSI, B800xH2200xD800 – self-supported, flat-packed for easy transport and installation .
 - Open Frame 19" Rack – includes cable organizers and slide rails for adjustable mounting .
 - Height Options – 2200 mm to 2740 mm, depth 800 mm, width 600–800 mm .

Fiber Optic Patch Panels

Patch panels or Optical Distribution Frames (ODF) are essential for terminating and managing fiber connections:

- Rack-mounted 1U-4U panels with sliding drawers for easy access .
- Adapter Compatibility – SC, LC, FC, ST, MPO/MTP interfaces .
- Construction – cold-rolled steel with electrostatic coating for durability .
- Cable Management – integrated splice trays and bend radius protection . CIF prices for patch panels typically range \$50-\$500 per unit, depending on port count and density.

Fiber Optic Cables

Cable costs vary by type, strand count, and application:

- Single-mode fiber: \$0.10-\$0.50 per foot.
- Multimode fiber: \$0.30-\$1.00 per foot.
