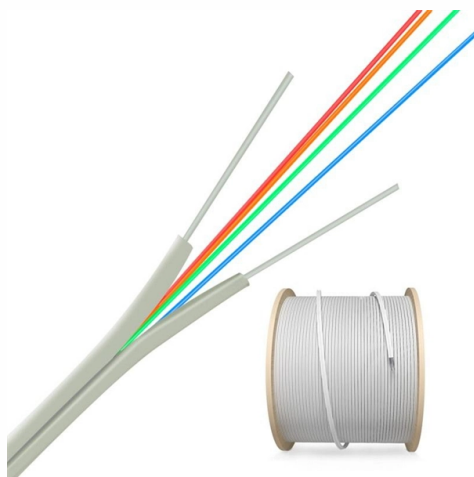


How far is the fiber distribution box from the user end



Overview

In short, the terminal box is the last structured node of the Fiber Optic System before service touches the subscriber. A typical PON topology (GPON, XGS-PON, or 25G PON) flows OLT → fiber distribution hub → passive splitters → distribution/drop fibers → premises. The terminal box sits at the end. Long distance from data center to end user's home is not convenient for installation, and costs are unimaginable. Given the above two aspects, the maximum number of users that can be accessed by such an office is only tens of households, and of course there is no application scenario.
