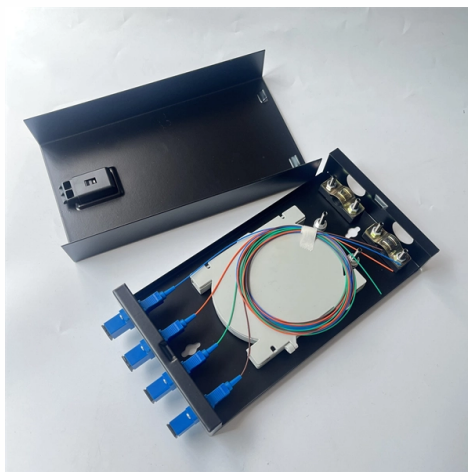


How to connect a 2-core fiber optic connector jack

- For pre-terminated connectors, simply ensure the connector clicks or locks into place and that the duplex clip is properly seated.

- Use an optical power meter or Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to verify signal strength and check for losses or reflections .

- Confirm that the Tx and Rx channels are correctly matched to avoid cross-talk or signal errors.

Step 6: Cable Management

- Route the duplex cable carefully, avoiding sharp bends that exceed the minimum bend radius.
