Before starting, ensure you have:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals for your router. Usually provided by your ISP .
- Fiber-ready router: Supports gigabit speeds or higher; check for SFP or WAN ports labeled for fiber .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically thin, yellow, with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable: To connect the ONT to your router .

• Power adapters for both ONT and router.

Step 2: Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home or office .
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port .

- Power on the ONT and wait 2–5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .
- Ensure the ONT is positioned close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port .
- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights (Power, Internet, Wi-Fi) to turn green .
- For advanced setups, SFP+ modules may be used for multi-gigabit connections .

Step 4: Configure Router Settings

- Access the router's admin interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1), .

- Enter your ISP-provided credentials to establish the internet connection .
- Update the router firmware to the latest version for security and performance .
- Set a strong Wi-Fi password and configure network name (SSID) for easy identification .

- Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you prioritize video calls, gaming, or VoIP .

Step 5: Optimize Wi-Fi and Network Performance

- Place the router in a central, open location to maximize coverage .
- Avoid sharp bends in fiber cables and keep connectors clean to prevent signal loss .
- Use wired connections for critical devices to reduce latency .
- Regularly monitor internet speed and adjust settings if needed .
- Consider upgrading to Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 routers to fully leverage fiber speeds .

Step 6: Troubleshooting

- If the internet light is red, check all connections and ensure the ONT is powered .
- Reboot the ONT and router if the connection fails.
- Contact your ISP if issues persist, as fiber connections require precise handling . By following these steps, your integrated fiber optic router will deliver high-speed, low-latency internet with stable Wi-Fi coverage, fully utilizing the advantages of fiber optic technology .
