To connect a home fiber optic cable to a router, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal, then link it to your router via an Ethernet cable.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts the incoming fiber optic signal into an electrical signal your router can use.
- Fiber optic cable: Usually pre-terminated with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors.
- Router: Ensure it has a WAN or SFP port compatible with Ethernet input from the ONT.
- Ethernet cable (Cat5e or higher): Connects the ONT to the router.

Step 2: Install the ONT

- Locate the fiber optic wall outlet installed by your ISP.
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated optical port. Handle the fiber connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage.

- Plug in the ONT power adapter and wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2–5 minutes .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port .

- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 4: Configure Your Router

- Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1), .
- Set up Wi-Fi, security settings, and enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for video calls or gaming .

Tips for Optimal Performance

- Place the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss .
- Keep both ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area with surge protection .
- Avoid bending or stressing the fiber cable; even small kinks can degrade performance .
- If the router has an SFP port, some models allow direct fiber connection, but most home setups require the ONT . By following these steps, your fiber optic internet should be properly connected and ready for high-speed, low-latency performance throughout your home network .
