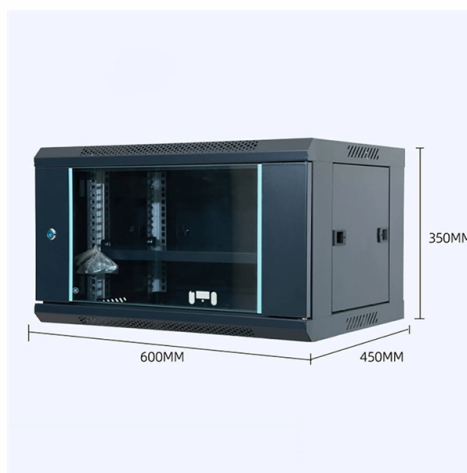


How to install copper busbars in a distribution box
