A cold joint occurs when fresh concrete is poured on top of a layer that has already begun to set, creating a visible line or discontinuity. This can happen due to delays, interruptions, or separate batches of concrete. If not managed correctly, cold joints can weaken the structure, increase water permeability, and compromise durability .

Steps to Create a Cold Joint

- Timing Considerations
 - Avoid delays longer than 30 minutes between pours to minimize the risk of a weak joint .
- If a delay is unavoidable, plan for proper surface preparation and bonding.
- Surface Preparation
 - Clean the hardened concrete surface thoroughly to remove debris, dust, and loose particles .
 - Roughen the surface using a bush hammer, scarifier, or wire brush to improve adhesion .

- Ensure the surface is slightly moistened but not saturated to enhance bonding.
- Applying a Bonding Agent
- Use a concrete bonding adhesive on both the old and new surfaces to improve adhesion .
- For partially hardened concrete, a rich mortar layer (about 12 mm thick) can be applied before pouring fresh concrete .
- Pouring Fresh Concrete
- Place the new concrete against the prepared surface promptly.
- Use systematic vibration to ensure the fresh concrete penetrates and integrates with the old layer .
- For thicker slabs, backer rods or closed-cell foam can be used to support the joint and prevent voids .
- Finishing
- Smooth and level the joint to match the surrounding surface.
- Allow proper curing to maintain moisture and prevent shrinkage cracks.

Tips for Best Results

- Use compatible concrete mixes for both layers to avoid differential shrinkage or bonding issues.
- Maintain moisture control during curing to enhance the joint's strength.
- If the old concrete has fully hardened, cut the joint to the required shape before applying bonding agents and fresh concrete . By following these steps, a cold joint can be made strong and durable, ensuring the concrete structure behaves as a cohesive unit despite interruptions in pouring .
