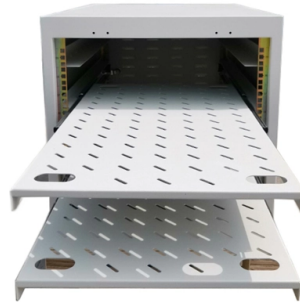

Maintaining Signal Integrity Ensure proper bend radius and avoid excessive pulling tension during installation. Test each fiber using tools like OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) or visual fault locators to verify signal quality and detect faults early .
