Step 1: Prepare the Equipment

Ensure you have the following items ready:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, which converts fiber signals into data your devices can use .
- Compatible router with a WAN or SFP port labeled for fiber or ONT input .
- Fiber optic cable (usually SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors) from the wall outlet to the ONT.
- Ethernet cable (CAT6 or higher recommended) to connect the ONT to the router .

Step 2: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable

- Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- Plug one end of the fiber optic cable into the wall outlet and the other into the ONT's designated port .



- Power on the ONT using the provided adapter and wait 2–5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .

Step 3: Connect the Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port .

- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 4: Optimize Router Placement

- Place the router centrally within your home to maximize Wi-Fi coverage .
- Avoid placing it near thick walls, metal objects, or electronic devices that may interfere with the signal.
- For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi devices to extend coverage .

Step 5: Configure the Network

- Access the router's admin panel via a browser (commonly 192.168.1.1) to set up Wi-Fi SSID, password, and security settings .
- Update the router firmware to the latest version for performance and security improvements .
- Optionally, configure advanced settings like Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize bandwidth for streaming or gaming .

Step 6: Test the Connection

- Verify that all devices can connect to the Wi-Fi network.
- Run a speed test to ensure the fiber connection is performing as expected . By following these steps, your indoor fiber optic router will be properly installed, providing high-speed, low-latency internet throughout your home or office. Proper placement, secure connections, and configuration are key to maximizing the benefits of fiber internet .

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
