

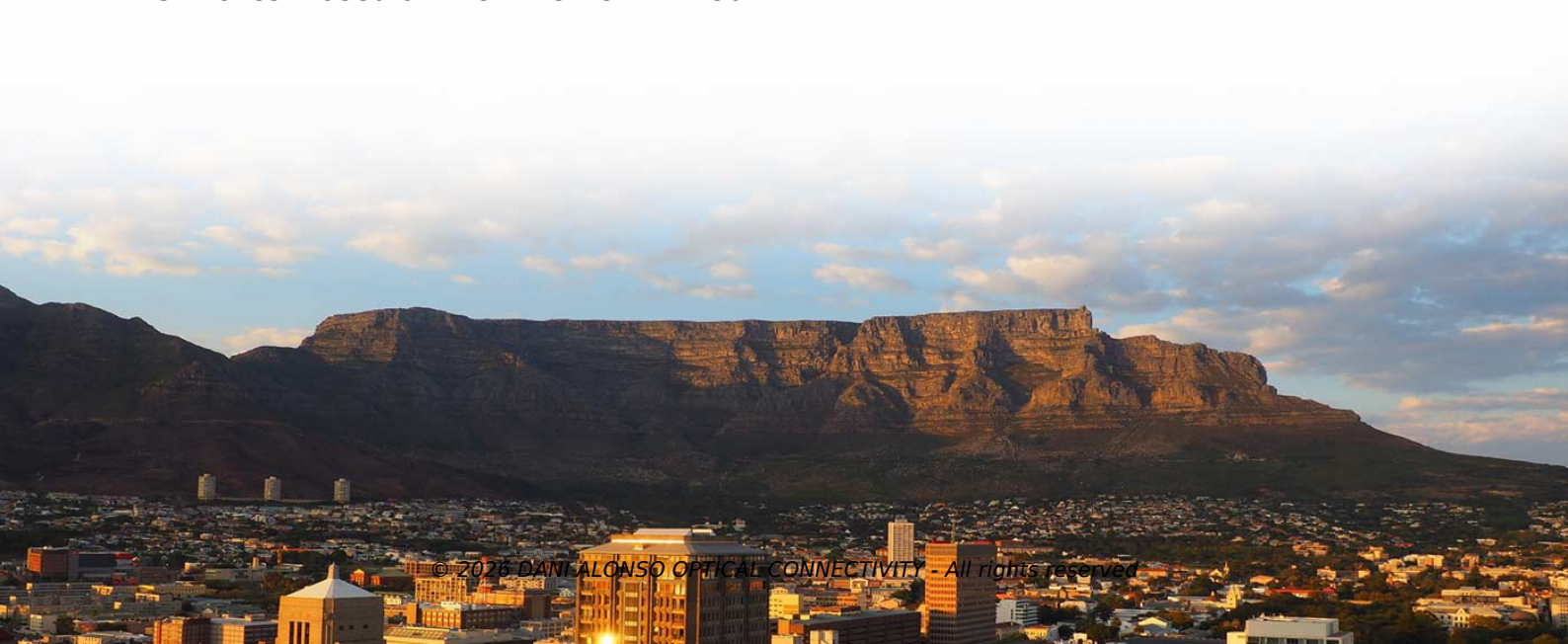

One of the most important functions of a managed PROFINET switch is the prioritisation of PROFINET telegram traffic in the machine network. You. Cisco IOS XE IE 9300 Rugged Series Switches support only PROFINET I/O, RT (Real-Time) but not IRT (isochronous real-time) communication.
