

Installing a fiber optic tray inside the pole

Before installation, ensure the pole is structurally sound and accessible. Use qualified technicians familiar with fiber optic handling and electrical safety practices. Mounting the Tray

- Select the appropriate tray type: Choose a fiber tray designed for vertical or confined spaces, such as a wire basket tray or a dedicated fiber tray with side channels .
- Position the tray: Align the tray vertically inside the pole, ensuring it is straight and level. Use temporary supports if necessary.
- Secure with fasteners: Insert T-bolts or flange bolts into the slots of the tray's side channels. Ensure the wings of the T-bolt remain inside the slots to prevent slippage. Finger-tighten initially, then fully tighten after confirming alignment .

- Attach end caps and vertical supports: End caps should be positioned on the outside of the side channel, and vertical supports should be inserted into the slots before fastening. This ensures stability and prevents tray movement .

Cable Management

- Route fiber carefully: Avoid sharp bends and maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. Use the tray's dividers to separate fibers and prevent tangling.
- Support vertical runs: For vertical installations inside poles, use cable ties or clips to support the fiber without crushing the core. Begin installation from the top to facilitate easier pulling and reduce stress on the fibers .
- Plan for expansion: Leave extra space in the tray for future fiber additions and ensure that all runs are straight and adequately supported .

Final Checks

- Verify that all fasteners are tight and the tray is stable.
- Ensure fibers are properly organized, with no excessive tension or bending.
- Confirm compliance with any local safety or electrical codes, especially if the pole is outdoors or near power lines .
