- **Regulatory Compliance:** Ensure trays meet NEC, NEMA, IEC, and local electrical codes for safety and inspection compliance .
- **Environmental Factors:** Consider exposure to moisture, chemicals, or outdoor conditions when choosing material and finish .
- **Load-Bearing Capacity:** Verify the tray can support the weight of installed cables and any future additions, including fittings and covers .
