- Double Armor: Combination of wire and tape for extreme mechanical protection, used in submarine or mining applications .

- Cooling and Coating Stations: Optional units to apply protective coatings or cooling for high-speed production. The process begins with a pre-insulated conductor bundle, followed by wrapping or braiding the metallic armor, and finally applying the outer sheath. Plants may include multiple lines for different cable types, such as single-core, multi-core, or fiber optic armored cables .
