

Price of fiber optic cable handling in computer room

Cost Breakdown

Materials: Fiber optic cable costs vary by type and quality. Indoor multimode cables (OM3/OM4) generally range from \$0.40 to \$6 per foot depending on strand count and jacket type, while single-mode cables may be slightly less per foot but require more expensive termination equipment. Pre-terminated patch cables and connectors add to the cost, with prices influenced by connector type and fiber count.

Labor: Labor is a significant component, especially for precise handling, routing, and termination in a computer room.
