Primary power distribution involves medium-voltage feeders, typically ranging from 2 kV to 33 kV, that carry electricity from a distribution substation to distribution transformers near the end-user or building. These feeders may be overhead or underground, depending on urban or rural settings, and are often protected by circuit breakers, fuses, or reclosers to isolate faults and ensure reliability . The primary distribution system is usually a three-phase, three-wire system to optimize conductor usage and support large loads .

Role in the Distribution Box



The distribution box (DB box) acts as the central hub for managing incoming primary power. It receives electricity from the primary feeder and distributes it to multiple circuits within a building or facility. Key components inside a DB box include:

- Busbars: Conductors that carry the incoming primary voltage and allow multiple circuits to connect.
 - Circuit breakers and fuses: Protect circuits from overloads or short circuits.
 - Indication lights: Show the status of mains power supply.
 - Optional smart modules: Enable energy monitoring and remote control for advanced management . The DB box ensures that primary voltage is safely routed to secondary distribution circuits, where it is stepped down by transformers to utilization voltage suitable for lighting, appliances, or industrial equipment .
- Connection to Secondary Distribution

From the DB box, power is either:

- Stepped down by a transformer to low-voltage circuits (e.g., 120/240 V for residential use), or
- Fed directly to large industrial loads if high power is required. This transition ensures that electricity is delivered safely and efficiently to all end-users while maintaining protection and control over the electrical network .
