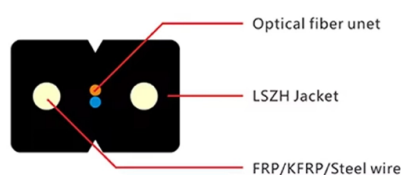


Reasons for power distribution box tripping at construction site
