Fiber Types

- Singlemode (OS2): Optimized for long-distance transmission with minimal attenuation.
- Multimode (OM3/OM4/OM5): Suitable for high-speed, short-to-medium distance connections, often used in data centers .

Cable Construction

Carrier-grade SC patch cords often feature:

- A-grade fiber cores for ultra-low insertion loss and high return loss .
- Reinforced aramid fiber strength members for durability and tensile strength .
- Jacket options: LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) for indoor safety, OFNP/OFNR for plenum or riser applications, and outdoor-rated jackets for environmental protection .

Performance Considerations

When selecting a carrier-grade SC patch cord, consider:

- Insertion Loss (IL): Lower IL ensures minimal signal degradation.
- Return Loss (RL): High RL is critical for minimizing reflections, especially in SC/APC connectors.
