For proper grounding of a distribution box:

- **Ground Wire Size:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is standard, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is used .
- **Connection Points:** Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate, then from the mounting plate to the central grounding point .
- **Resistance Requirement:** The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm .
- **Alternative Configurations:** For longer tool cable runs or multiple spindles, larger wires (e.g., 16 mm² or 6 AWG) may be required to maintain low resistance .

Cost Considerations

The total cost depends on labor, materials, permits, and site conditions:

- **Basic Setup:** Short runs with one grounding rod, minimal labor, and standard materials can cost \$400-\$420 .
- **Mid-Range Setup:** Two rods, longer conductor runs, and standard testing typically cost \$700-\$1,100 .
- **Premium/Complex Setup:** Multiple rods, long runs, enhanced testing, or permit coordination can cost \$1,400-\$2,000 . **Labor Rates:** Electricians typically charge \$75-\$140 per hour, depending on region and experience . **Materials:** Copper rods, clamps, and grounding conductors are the main material costs, ranging from \$30 to \$180 depending on system complexity .
