Immediately turn off the main breaker to cut all power to the panel and prevent further overheating . If smoke, sparks, or flames are present, evacuate the area and call emergency services . Ventilate the area by opening windows and doors to reduce inhalation of toxic fumes .

Common Causes

- Loose Connections: Screws or terminals inside the panel can loosen over time, creating gaps that generate intense localized heat and electrical arcing, which melts insulation and plastic components .

- **Circuit Overload:** Running multiple high-power devices on a single circuit can exceed the wire's capacity, causing overheating. Even if the breaker trips, sustained overload can damage internal components .
 - **Faulty or Aged Breaker:** Breakers themselves can degrade, with pitted or corroded contacts creating high resistance points that overheat and emit a burning odor .
 - **Internal Component Failure:** Over time, mechanical or thermal parts inside the breaker can fail, producing heat and chemical odors without visible sparks .
- Recommended Next Steps

- Keep the panel de-energized until inspected by a licensed electrician .
- Do not attempt repairs yourself; opening the panel or touching components can expose you to live electricity .
- Document the symptoms: note the smell, any tripping patterns, and devices in use at the time. This helps the electrician diagnose the root cause efficiently .
- Avoid using appliances on the affected circuit until the issue is resolved .
