In some designs, a cabinet at floor level, usually on the top floor, houses the main electronic components that require interaction with technical staff, while the power box remains in the shaft.

Accessibility Considerations

The power box is designed to be accessible for maintenance and emergency operations, such as manual lowering of the elevator or accessing cut-off valves and controls. Access panels are typically provided to allow technicians to reach these components safely without removing the entire unit. The installation height is dictated by the need to reach emergency controls and valves easily.

Compliance with Electrical Codes

According to NEC requirements, in elevators without a machine room, the overcurrent device or disconnecting means must be located outside the hoistway and accessible only to qualified personnel . This ensures safety while maintaining compliance with electrical standards. The power distribution box may include fuses or circuit breakers designed to coordinate with the elevator controller for proper fault protection .
