- Possible Causes

 - Measure voltage: Use a voltmeter to check the voltage at the power supply and at the distribution box. A significant drop may indicate cable issues or insufficient power .
 - Restart the system: Some distribution boxes may require a system reset to clear minor faults or indicator errors .
- Preventive Measures
- Regularly inspect and maintain the distribution box, tightening connections and cleaning dust or debris .
 - Ensure proper wire sizing and minimize long cable runs to prevent voltage drops .
 - Keep the box dry and protected from environmental factors like moisture and heat .
 - Schedule periodic checks of fuses, breakers, and indicator lights to catch issues early . If the dim red light persists after these checks, it is recommended to consult a licensed electrician to safely diagnose and repair any underlying electrical faults .
