The enclosure is tamper-resistant, grounded, and filled with insulating fluid to protect the internal components and prevent electrical hazards .

Safety Considerations

While the box is designed to be safe for nearby residents, it contains live, high-voltage equipment that can cause severe injury or death if tampered with . Key safety guidelines include:



- Do not open, climb on, or tamper with the box.
- Keep children and pets away from the enclosure.
- Maintain clearances: leave at least 10 feet in front and 3 feet on the sides for maintenance access .
- Exercise caution when digging near the box; contact local utility services (e.g., 811 in the U.S.) before any excavation .
- Vegetation management: it is safe to mow or trim grass around the base, but avoid planting trees or shrubs too close .

The box is part of the final step in electricity distribution from the power plant to your home, making it essential for reliable power delivery . Although it emits electromagnetic fields (EMF), the intensity drops rapidly with distance, and leaving the box alone generally poses minimal risk . For optimal safety, avoid prolonged close contact and follow recommended clearances.
