Support Spacing and Mounting

- Maintain a maximum distance of 1.2 meters between supports to prevent sagging of trays and ladders .
 - Provide additional supports at 150 mm for bends, branches, and offsets to ensure stability .
 - Cable trays should be securely mounted according to approved shop drawings and project specifications .
- #### Material Handling and Storage
- Inspect all materials upon delivery to ensure compliance with approved submittals and check for damage .
 - Store trays and ladders horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at 1-meter intervals, protecting them from moisture and direct sunlight .
- #### Cable Types and Fill Limits

- Use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables .
- For power cables, the tray fill must not exceed 40% of the cross-sectional area; for control cables, 50% .
- Separate high-power and low-power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) . Clearances and Prohibited Areas
- Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access .
- Cable trays should not be installed in hoistways or enclosed spaces and must remain accessible . Grounding and Materials
- Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if they meet NEC or equivalent standards .
- Choose tray materials (aluminum, steel, or FRP) based on environmental conditions and load requirements . Installation Procedure
- Review approved shop drawings for layout, length, and location .
- Prepare materials and verify their suitability .
- Install supports and trays according to the method statement and project specifications .
- Inspect the completed installation to ensure compliance with safety and performance requirements . Safety Considerations
- Proper installation is critical to prevent personal injury and property damage .
- Follow inspection checklists and method statements to ensure reliable and organized electrical systems . By following these guidelines, cable tray installations in Tuvalu can achieve structural integrity, electrical safety, and compliance with recognized standards while accommodating the tropical environment.
