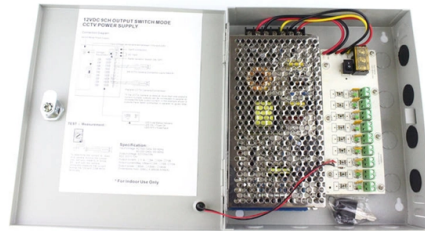

- **Inspect Hardware and Connections:** Check all fiber, Ethernet, and power cables for damage, loose connections, or wear. Ensure connectors are clean and properly seated, and use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat 6 or higher) for gigabit speeds .
- **Check Router Settings:** Verify that your router supports your ISP's configuration, including PPPoE, VLAN tagging, and MTU settings. Update firmware to the latest version and reset to factory defaults if necessary .
- **Test Direct Connection:** Connect a device directly to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or modem. If the connection stabilizes, the issue likely lies with the router or its configuration .
- **Reduce Environmental Interference:** Keep the router away from other electronic devices, avoid excessive bending of fiber cables, and ensure proper ventilation to prevent overheating .
- **Contact Your ISP:** If problems persist, your ISP can check for network outages, signal fluctuations, or fiber line issues and provide replacement equipment if needed .

Preventive Measures

- Regularly clean fiber connectors and inspect cables for damage.
- Avoid sharp bends or mechanical stress on fiber lines.
- Keep router firmware updated and periodically reboot devices.
- Use mesh systems or Wi-Fi extenders to improve coverage in larger homes . By systematically addressing hardware, configuration, and environmental factors, most fiber optic router instability issues can be resolved, ensuring a reliable high-speed internet experience.
