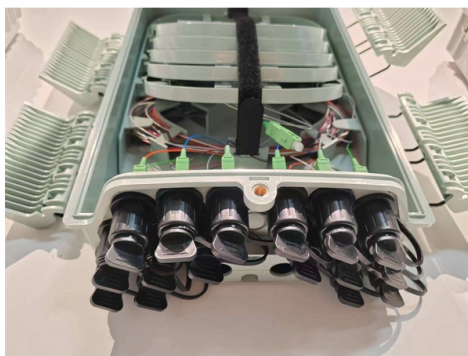

A metering module (sometimes called a utility metering module or power metering module) is the internal hardware block responsible for measuring electrical parameters and producing trustworthy consumption data. It is used in electricity meters, smart meters, and submetering systems.

Key Functions

- Voltage & current sensing: Captures polyphase or single-phase electrical signals.
- Analog-to-digital conversion (ADC): Converts analog waveforms into digital samples at high frequency for precision.
- Digital signal processing (DSP): Computes real power, energy (Wh), RMS voltage, and other metrics.
- Real-time clock (RTC): Provides trusted timestamps for time-of-use (TOU) billing and event logs.

- Tamper detection: Generates structured evidence of tampering attempts.
- Secure data handling: Some modules include encryption, authentication, and secure storage.
- Communication interface: Exposes measurement data via SPI, UART, I²C, Wi-Fi, cellular, or Modbus.

Types of Metering Modules

- Power metering modules: Focus on measurement accuracy for single-phase or three-phase systems.
- Embedded security modules (ESAM): Add encryption, authentication, and secure data storage.
- Communication modules: Wi-Fi, cellular, or wired interfaces for remote data transmission.

How They Work

- Signal sampling using CTs, shunts, or resistor dividers.
- ADC digitization at high sampling rates (often >4 kHz).
- DSP algorithms compute energy and correct errors (gain, phase, temperature drift).
- Event logging & timestamping ensure traceability.
- Data output to the host controller or cloud system.
