- **Seven-Shaped Buckle Fixing** A specialized buckle design that hooks onto the tray and cover, providing a quick and reusable fastening option. It is suitable for light-duty or temporary installations .

- **Cover Clamps (PKP-SP Series)** Mechanical cover clamps, such as PKP-SP1, PKP-SP2, and PKP-SPM1, are used for demanding conditions like vertical installations or exposure to wind. Some clamps require screwing into position, while others snap on without tools. They are compatible with perforated or mesh cable trays and provide additional security .

- **Maintenance Access:** Quick-release buckles or snap-on clamps allow easier removal for cable inspection.

- **Vibration Resistance:** Screw or pressing plate methods provide stronger hold in areas with vibration .
