Fiber optic internet usually requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the light signals from the fiber cable into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment. The fiber optic cable from your ISP plugs into the ONT's designated fiber port, often using SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .

Router Port for Fiber Connection

Once the ONT receives the fiber signal, it connects to your router using one of the following ports:

- **WAN Port (Ethernet):** Most home routers use a standard Ethernet WAN port to receive the internet signal from the ONT. You connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port using a Cat6 or higher Ethernet cable .



- SFP Port (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Some fiber-ready routers have a dedicated SFP or SFP+ slot that allows direct insertion of a fiber optic module. This is common in high-speed or enterprise setups and supports direct fiber input without an ONT .

Identifying the Correct Port

- Look for labels such as “WAN,” “Internet,” or “Fiber” on the router .
- The port may be color-coded or slightly separated from LAN ports to indicate its purpose.
- If your router supports SFP modules, the slot is usually a small rectangular port designed for fiber transceivers .

Summary

In most residential setups, the fiber optic cable connects first to the ONT, and then the ONT connects to the router's WAN port via Ethernet. For fiber-ready routers with SFP support, the fiber can connect directly to the SFP/fiber port. Always check your router's manual for the exact port designation to ensure proper connection and optimal performance .
