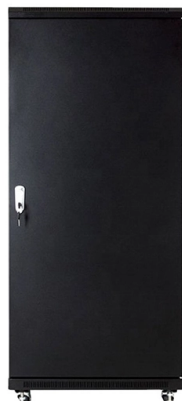

Where is the best place to put the main power distribution box on the construction site

Location and Accessibility

Height and Mounting

Safety and Protection

- Use a metal or high-quality insulating enclosure with proper thickness (≥ 1.5 mm for metal boxes) to protect internal components .
- Ensure grounding of the metal box, mounting plate, and electrical appliances inside the box, with the protective neutral connected through a terminal board .
- Install leakage protection devices and separate circuits for power and lighting to enhance safety .
- Maintain proper IP55 or higher protection rating to safeguard against dust and water ingress, especially in outdoor or harsh environments .

Wiring and Distance Considerations

- Use insulated, high-temperature-resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load .
- The distance between the main distribution box and secondary distribution or switch boxes should not exceed 30 meters, and the distance to controlled equipment should not exceed 3 meters .
- Ensure neat cable management, secure connections, and no exposed live parts to prevent short circuits or fire hazards . By following these guidelines, the primary power distribution box will be safely and efficiently installed, ensuring reliable power distribution and compliance with construction site safety standards.
